

International Master Program in Asia-Pacific Affairs Incentive Guidelines, National Sun Yat-sen University

Approved by the 7th Program Affairs Meeting for the Academic Year 2012 on May 21, 2013

I. To encourage students of this Program to participate actively in domestic and international academic activities, these Guidelines have been enacted. The source of funding for these Guidelines is the operating expenses of this Program. Applications for all subsidies and awards set forth in these Guidelines shall be reviewed by the Program Affairs Meeting.

II. Awards for Academic Papers

- (i) For students who publish in SSCI journals, each paper will be awarded NT\$10,000.
- (ii) For students who publish in non-SSCI but international journals that employ a double-blind peer-review system, each paper will be awarded NT\$5,000.
- (iii) For students who publish in domestic journals that employ a double-blind peer-review system, each paper will be awarded NT\$2,000.

These awards can be applied any time by submitting required documentations. A paper should be published in the name of the Program, and the applicant should be the single author of the paper or the first author of a co-written paper.

III. Subsidies for International Academic Activities

- (i) For students who participate in exchange student program, a subsidy of NT\$10,000 will be given each time if they choose to study in Asia (including mainland China), and a subsidy of NT\$20,000 will be given each time if they choose to study in Europe or the United States.
- (ii) For students who attend an international conference and present a paper in the conference, a subsidy of NT\$10,000 will be given each time when these academic activities are conducted in Asia, and a subsidy of NT\$20,000 will be given each time when these academic activities are conducted in Europe or the United States.

These subsidies will be given based on the principle that per applicant makes an application per year, and no more than two applications are made during the whole period of the applicant's studies. The applicant can apply for these subsidies any time by submitting required documentations.

IV. Support Funds

Qualification: IMAPA Students introduce a new student to the program, who confirmed to finish the registration process.

Application Time: During the application submission period. Fall admission: January 15th ~ March 31st 2021. Spring admission: August 1st ~ September 30th 2021.

This Program provides support funds to those who introduce new students. Each fund recipient will receive NT\$50,000 in the end of the semester. This fund can only be applied once per semester.

The list of fund recipients will be submitted by the Program to the Director for approval.

V. These Guidelines will be implemented upon approval by the Program Affairs Meeting.

Amendments to the Guidelines shall be processed accordingly.
