Regulations for the Review of Credit Transfer and Course Waiver of In-Service
Master's Programs

Approved at the 4th Curricular Committee Meeting of AY2001 on May 21, 2002

- Article 1 Students enrolling to the IOE in-service master's programs should apply for credit transfer and course waiver according to these Regulations.
- Article 2 The following students may apply for credit transfer and course waiver.
1. Students enrolling on an extension education master's credit program.
 2. Students approved for taking master's program courses with credits (including non-degree student courses) in advance according to related regulations with a certificate of credits or transcript and admitted to an IOE in-service master's program.
- Article 3 Scope of credit transfer
Credits for electives.
- Article 4 Waiver of courses
1. Courses with the same title and contents: To be approved for waiver by the course teacher.
 2. Courses with the same title and similar contents: To be approved for waiver by the course teacher.
- Article 5 Settlement of credit transfer for courses with different credits
Courses with more credits to courses with less credits: Less credits will be registered after the transfer.
- Article 6 Courses and credits: Students may apply for credit transfer for electives with a score of over 80 marks.
- Article 7 Students are allowed to apply for credit transfer and course waiver for one time only. Applications made after the deadline will not be considered.
When applying for credit transfer and course waiver, students must submit the certificate of credit (exempted when none), the certificate of completion of the course for waiver/credit for transfer, and the transcript.
- Article 8 Students should apply for credit transfer and course waiver according to the school calendar in the semester of enrollment.
- Article 9 Students can apply for credit transfer and course waiver of not more than 12 credits.
- Article 10 The credit transfer and course waiver will be approved by the IOE Curriculum Committee after discussion.
- Article 11 Matters not provided for in these Regulations will be subject to the regulations governing credit transfer and course waiver of the NSYSU.
- Article 12 These Regulations will be implemented after the approval of the IOE Curriculum Committee. The same shall apply to the amendments thereto.
