Guidelines for Selecting Excellent Teacher in Teaching of College of Engineering, National Sun Yat-sen University

Passed at the 4th College Affairs Meeting of the 2010 academic year on April 15, 2011

- I. The Guidelines for Selecting Excellent Teacher in Teaching (hereinafter referred to as "the Guidelines") of the College of Engineering, National Sun Yat-sen University are formulated in accordance with "National Sun Yat-Sen University Principles for Recruitment and Retention of Special Outstanding and Talented Faculty" and "National Sun Yat-Sen University Implementation Regulations for Recruitment and Retention of Special Outstanding and Talented Faculty" in order to award teachers for their excellent performance in teaching.
- II. The dean shall assume the convener and ex officio member of Excellent Teacher in Teaching Selection Committee, which shall consist of one professor elected by each department/institute of the College and at least three faculty representatives from the other colleges (including the Si Wan College) who have won the University's Distinguished Professor in Teaching Award (Teaching Excellence Award), Outstanding Teaching Award, Excellent Teacher in Teaching Award, or Excellent Teaching Award.
- III. The applicants who apply for the Excellent Teacher in Teaching Award shall meet the requirements specified in National Sun Yat-sen University Implementation Plan for Academic Ethics as well as the following basic eligibilities:
 - 1. Teaching Achievements Eligibility must meet one or more of the following requirements:
 - (1) Received at least one "Excellent Course" Award granted by the University President for at least one course during the previous academic year.
 - (2) The average satisfaction score of Teaching Assessment Survey for all courses taught in the previous academic year is higher than that of the College.
 - (3) The average satisfaction score for teaching performance in the previous

- academic year according to the Survey on Graduating Students' Satisfaction with Department/Institute and Faculty is higher than that of the College.
- (4) Demonstrate long-term commitment to teaching with supporting evidence, which shall pass the review by the affiliated department, institute, education center, program, or the Office of Academic Affairs as well as the College(including the Si Wan College)'s "Excellent Teacher in Teaching Selection Committee."
- 2. Teaching and Service Eligibility—must meet one or more of the following requirements:
 - (1) Teach at least one course at the Si Wan College in the previous academic year (co-taught by up to three faculty members) or teach a course worth one or more credits in one academic year.
 - (2) Teach at least one compulsory undergraduate course in the previous academic year.
 - (3) Teach at least one English-instructed course in the previous academic year.
 - (4)Pass the E-learning Course Certification approved by the Ministry of Education in the previous academic year.
 - (5)The three-year average teaching workload for lecture courses and compulsory laboratory courses is higher than the average teaching workload of the College's full-time teachers. Sabbatical leave semesters are not required to be included in the calculation. Reduced teaching hours may be applied to semesters with joint administrative responsibilities.
- 3. The College's Basic Eligibility must meet all the following requirements:
 - (1) Serve as the University's full-time professor, associate professor, assistant professor, lecturer, or contracted faculty member for three years or more.
 - (2) Those who are full-time faculty members shall meet the teaching-hour requirement as stated in the University's "Calculation Guidelines of Hourly Pay for Teachers" during the academic year prior to the application. Those who are contracted faulty members shall meet the related teaching-hour requirement for the Full-time faculty member.
 - (3) The three-year average teaching workload for lecture courses and compulsory laboratory courses is higher than 50% or more of the average teaching workload of the applicant's affiliated department/institute. Sabbatical leave semesters are not required to be included in the calculation. Reduced teaching hours may be applied to semesters with joint administrative responsibilities.

The number of semesters in which the teacher is on vacation and takes maternity leave, childbirth leave and parental leave pursuant to laws may be calculated retroactively, according to the items 1-3 of the subparagraph 1, items 1-3 of subparagraph 2, item 2 of subparagraph 3 of the preceding paragraph.

- IV. The faculty member who meets the eligibility requirements and wish for application shall complete the College's Application Form for Excellent Teacher in Teaching Award and submit it to the College.
- V. Two-thirds or more of the committee members must attend the meeting of the Excellent Teacher in Teaching Selection Committee. The members shall not appoint others to act as their proxies. The award selection shall be subject to the approval of at least second-thirds or more of the attended members.
- VI. The College's selection of Excellent Teachers in Teaching shall be processed in accordance with the provisions of this Guidelines as per the schedule announced by the Office of Academic Affairs. The Excellent Teacher in Teaching Selection Committee shall rank candidates and select a number of suitable nominees to create the College's Excellent Teachers in Teaching Nomination List (up to a maximum of 10 percent of the College's full-time faculty). Recommendations to the Office of Academic Affairs shall be sorted according to the Committee's ranked order. The College may recommend the top 50 percent nominees on the Nomination List for the annual selection of Distinguished Professor in Teaching Award (Teaching Excellence Award).
- VII. Matters not stated in the Guidelines shall be handled according to the University's statutory requirements and relevant regulations.
- VIII. The Guidelines, as well as its amendments, become effective upon approval by the College Affairs Meeting and the Academic Affairs Meeting.
