Department of Computer Science and Engineering Guidelines Governing Scholarship for Outstanding Graduate Students

Approved and issued by the Department General Meeting on August 10, 2011.

- I. These guidelines are established to encourage outstanding students who wish to study at Department of Computer Science and Engineering (hereafter referred to as “the Department”).
- II. The origin of scholarship is Graduate Student Scholarship Funding under the Department.
- III. Applicants who apply for Master’s Admission by Screening and Recommendation or Ph.D. Program Entrance Examination and meet the qualifications listed as follows are eligible for the scholarship:
 - a. Applicants have actual achievement of academic research in the related fields of Computer Science and Engineering and are one of the authors;
 - b. Applicants participated in competitions at national level in the related fields of Computer Science and Engineering, and win a prize;
 - c. Outstanding Students of the Department;
 - d. Applicants studied at national institutions in Taiwan majored in related subjects to Computer Science and Engineering, and ranked top 10 percentages of the class;
 - e. Applicants studied at private institutions in Taiwan majored in related subjects to Computer Science and Engineering, and ranked top 5 percentages of the class;
 - f. Outstanding international applicants.
- IV. Application Methods:

Applicants must submit the application form and attach required documents by assigned deadline of the Department.

 - a. Applicants registered as Master’s Admission by Screening and Recommendation or Ph.D. Entrance Examination candidates may apply for the scholarship by attaching scholarship application form with their application documents.
 - b. Applicants admitted as a master’s student of the Department may apply for it within two weeks after completing registration (Report at the Department) procedure.
 - c. Applicants registered as preparatory graduate student for Ph.D. program candidates may apply for the scholarship in the next application term.
- V. The amount of scholarship will be provided based on the award unit determined by the director depending on the Department’s budget each year. The duration for the scholarship shall be one year. The number of master’s awardees is limited to 5 students each year and the amount of scholarship will be 1 award unit for each awardee per month. The scholarship will be revoked if master’s awardees who have been awarded any other scholarships bestowed by the government or school. The number of doctoral awardees is limited to 5 students each year and the amount of scholarship will be 4 award units for each awardee per month.
- VI. The award list will be determined by the Department Admission Committee.

- VII. The present guidelines shall be implemented following approvals of the Department General Meetings and submitted to the Division of Student Affairs for future references. The same procedure shall be carried out when amendments are to be made.
