National Sun Yat-sen University Department of Electrical Engineering Regulations for Alumni Scholarship for Children in School

Article 1: Mission

The Department of Electrical Engineering Alumni Association Board of National Sun Yat-sen University (hereinafter referred to as "the Association") has established the "Scholarship for Children of Department of Electrical Engineering Alumni of National Sun Yat-sen University" (hereinafter referred to as "the Scholarship") in order to encourage children of the Department who are currently enrolled in public or private junior high schools and high schools (including senior high schools and grades 1 to 3 of 5) in Taiwan to pursue their studies with integrity.

- Article 2: The eligibility, quota and amount of the scholarship are as follows.
 - 1. Children of our alumni who are currently enrolled in junior high school or high school (including senior high schools and grades 1 to 3 of 5).
 - 2. The number of scholarships is 35 for junior high school students and 70 for senior high school students per year, and the scholarship and certificate will be awarded after the evaluation.
 - 3. The eligibility requirements for applicants are as follows:
 - (1) Students with an overall academic average of at least 80 points in junior high school and at least 75 points in high school in the previous semester; no adverse comments on the moral assessment or daily assessment.
 - (2) Those who have special deeds and performance.
- Article 3: Students who meet the application requirements should apply to the Association in March each year in accordance with the following procedures.
 - 1. One application form to be signed by the student and his/her parents (departmental alumni)
 - 2. Attach an original copy of the previous semester's transcript (including moral or daily evaluations)
 - 3. Attach a copy of the front and back of the applicant's identity card or a copy of the Household Certificate.
 - 4. A concise autobiography of 500 words or less, in the student's own handwriting only. (Parental writing is not acceptable.)
 - 5. Applications should be mailed by March 15 of each year and postmarked.
- Article 4: The Association shall authorize the chairperson of the Department to convene a review committee (including a representative of the Association) to conduct the review and selection.
- Article 5: If there are any matters not covered by these Regulations, the Association may amend them at any time.
- Article 6: These regulations shall be implemented following approvals of the Association meetings. The same procedure shall be carried out when amendments are to be made.
