- The following rules are intended to encourage the undergraduate students of NSYSU's
 Department of Music to enhance their technical skills and performance abilities with
 their specialized instruments.
- One student in each area of specialty will receive an award. For areas of specialty with more students, one student for every eight students in that specialty will receive an award.
- 3.) Award criteria: Eligible students must have an average grade of 85 across their classes for the semester (not including small assignments and quizzes); if there are multiple eligible students, recipients will be selected first by their technical exam grades, then by their academic performance. Recipients will receive a certificate; those who are found in violation of the rules will be disqualified and will not be replaced by the student with the next-highest grades.
- 4.) These measures, as have subsequent amendments, have been implemented after having been discussed and approved by the department's faculty committee.
