National Sun Yat-sen University Department of Theater Arts Implementation Guidelines for Master's Program Practicum

Applicable to New Students Admitted in the Academic Year 2018

Formulated at the 9th Department Affairs Council Meeting, Academic Year 2019, January 28, 2010

Amendment approved at the 5th Department Affairs Council Meeting, Academic Year 2017, May 31, 2018

- The guidelines were formulated in accordance with the Master's Program Mandatory Course Planning and Course Implementation Principles.
- 2. Arts Management students who wish to undertake the elective Practicum course must take the "Art Management" course offered by the Department as a prerequisite.
- 3. During the Practicum period, the course instructor shall, based on each student's specialty, recommend the student to external arts & culture programs at outside institutions for their practicum. Each outside institution should not host more than 3 students at the same time and the total time of the practicum should be 90 hours per credit. The practicum may be carried out during the semester or the winter and summer breaks but must be completed by the end of the following semester.
- 4. The external practicum application must be proposed 2 months before the start time and requires the approval of all course instructors.
- 5. These guidelines were approved by the Department Affairs Council prior to implementation. Modifications shall follow the same procedure.
