## **Guidelines on Establishment of College General Meeting**

- I. The present guidelines are issued in accordance with the provisions specified in the "Organization Act of the National Sun Yat-sen University".
- II. The Committee constitutes the Dean, Associate Dean(s), Chairs, Directors, faculty representatives of departments and institutes, with the Dean as the Committee convener.
- III. Faculty representatives shall be generated by each department or institute based on the number of faculty, one representative for every four faculty members (except supervisors). Each department or institute shall have at least one representative, and the term of the committee is 1 years, with prospect of reelection.
- IV. At least one meeting shall be held each semester, and is convened by the Dean or after being co-sign by more than one third and above of the number of representatives. with additional temporary meetings if necessary. The meeting must be convened by more than two-thirds and above of members attending the meeting. Representatives who are unable to attend may appoint an agent.
- V. The faculty and staff members may sit in on the College General Meeting. When discussing related faculty, staff or student affairs, the parties or their representatives may be invited to attend.
- VI. The guidelines shall be approved by the College General Meeting. The same procedure shall be carried out when amendments are to be made.
